
European Action Day Against Islamophobia-21 September

Security, Democracy and Cities 2021 Seville DE NICE





What is SBD?

'Security by Design' (SBD) is a concept in the protection of public spaces that promotes the idea that security is best achieved if addressed from the very beginning of the planning and design of a public space.

This concept is the guiding principle of the European Commission's 'Action Plan to Support the Protection of Public Spaces' and is also endorsed and applied by the SOAR 'Strengthening the security and resilience of at-risk religious sites and communities' programme.





