

Austrian Police Hate Crime Report

WHEN: 2022

WHERE: AUSTRIA

The Austrian Federal Ministry of the Interior published the annual Hate Crime Report 2022. According to the report, in 2022, the Austrian police recorded 5,865 hate crimes. Out of the 5,865 hate crimes, 630 cases are based on religion, 373 cases based on skin colour, 1,968 cases based on national/ethnic origin, and 2,466 cases based on belief.

Research paper on antisemitism

WHEN: JULY

The Humanities and Social Sciences Communications journal published a paper that looks at whether antisemitism is more common among left or right-wing individuals. The study shows that antisemitism is "associated with a conspiracist view of the world, a desire to overturn the social order, and a preference for authoritarian forms of government. The paper is authored by Daniel Allington, David Hirsh, and Louise Katz.



Antisemitische Einstellungen in Deutschland

Repräsentative Umfrage zur Verbreitung von antisemitischen Einstellungen in der deutschen Bevölkerung Dominik Hirndorf

- Eine große Mehrheit der deutschen Bevölkerung lehnt antisemitische Aussagen entschieden ab. Die Zustimmung fällt mit Werten von 2 bis 6 Prozent zu einzelnen antisemitischen Aussagen gering aus.
- Erhöhte Zustimmung findet sich unter Personen mit niedrigem formalen Bildungsabschluss, unter Menschen mit muslimischem Glauben und/oder Migrationshintergrund sowie innerhalb der AfD-Anhängerschaft.
- Personen mit links- und rechtsextremistischen Einstellungen weisen signifikant häufiger antisemitische Einstellungen auf. Der Effekt fällt allerdings stärker bei einer Neigung zu rechtsextremistischen Einstellungen aus.
- Verschwörungsglaube und klassischer Antisemitismus sind verknüpft. Personen, die an die Existenz geheimer Mächte glauben, stimmen überdurchschnittlich dem antisemitischen Vorurteil zu, dass "reiche Juden die eigentlichen Herrscher der Welt sind".





Anti-Semitic attitudes in Germany

In July, the Konrad Adenauer
Foundation published the
"Antisemitic Attitudes in Germany"
paper. According to the paper a
"large majority of the German
population firmly rejects antiSemitic statements." However, the
paper also uncovered that "people
with left-wing and right-wing
extremist attitudes exhibit
significantly more anti-Semitic
attitudes."

Anti-Semitic incidents in Lower Saxony


WHEN: 2022

RIAS has published the Anti-Semitic incidents in Lower Saxony 2022 report. The report documents 100 anti-Semitic incidents. 86 incidents were clarified as abusive behaviour, 2 mass letters, 2 attacks, 2 extreme violence cases, 6 damages to property, and 2 threats.





